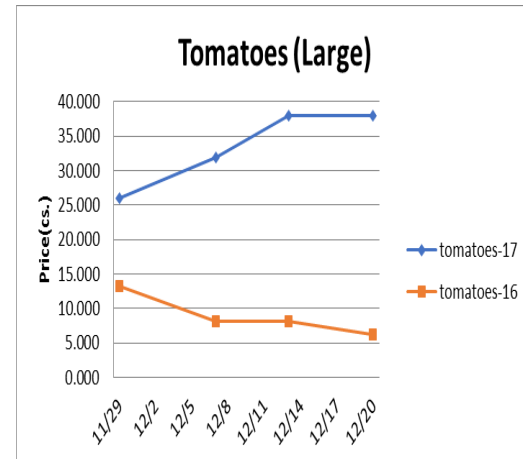


Produce

The tomato markets remain elevated, rising 138% during the last six-weeks matching their most expensive level of the last decade. The Florida tomato harvest continues to struggle due to damage from Hurricane Irma during the late summer. Tomato shipments from Florida did marginally improve last week but were still 59% less than the previous year. Tomato supplies could improve as the winter progresses which eventually should put downward pressure on prices. The avocado markets could remain historically elevated in 2018.
